## **ALMEX AS-10**

This machine was similar in appearance to the Almex AS-8, but had a dial that was turned to select the station required, then one of four buttons pressed to select the ticket type. The fare was then displayed which decreased as the coins were inserted. When the amount reached zero, the ticket was issued. The machine did not give change.

Machines were provided at stations on the St Pancras to Bedford line, issuing tickets 110mm long and showed the 'Midland Electrics' title, which later changed to 'Thameslink'. The top line showed the ticket number, issuing station and destination. The bottom line showed the machine number, the first 2 digits indicated the year of issue and the letter indicated the station of issue. This was followed by the ticket type, then time, fare and date of issue. These machines were replaced by the Ascom B8050.

The machines on the Scottish region issued tickets 75mm long. Tickets from those in the Strathclyde area showed the issuing station, whilst the Scot Rail tickets show the destination station. All machines have now been removed.

Machines are also located on the Renfrew Ferry, showing the Strathclyde PTE and BR logo's.
