

# MIDLAND METRO

## TLCS

Midland Metro. Jnl 271/1999

The machines have 3 rows of eight buttons lettered A to Z (except I and O) and 3 buttons for Child, Family and Return. Buttons A to F are for fares to destinations on the system and the other buttons are used for Centrocards etc. and for transfers to bus and train. A monitor screen displays the route and tramstops. To select a fare, reference is made to a chart and the relevant button is pressed. The display now shows the fare. If a Child or Return fare is required the relevant button is pressed and the displayed fare is adjusted. Coins are inserted then ticket is issued followed by any change due.

From early 2001, only machines at Birmingham Snow Hill and Wolverhampton St George were in use and on-board conductors equipped with Clipper machines are now employed.

Note: Machine 27 does not exist and 57 is the test machine at the depot.
